ASL administration will monitor weather each day. In the event that games are cancelled...

- Officiating Staff will be notified via slack as soon as decision is made
- Players/Teams will be notified by 4 pm on the day of play via facebook/twitter (/playaugusta)
- Or 2 hours prior to games start on weekends/corporate events
- IF YOU ARRIVE AT FIELDS, and they have been damaged due to scattered showers, contact ASL admin immediately.

If games continue as regularly scheduled, lead officials and/or coordinators are to use the following procedures:

• LIGHTNING

- If lightning can be seen in the distance, the lead official is to bring both team captains together to get their input
 - If both team captains agree to continue play, play will resume
 - If only one or none of the team captains wishes to continue, game will be called (follow rules of play)
- If lightning appears close or impending, games will be immediately cancelled, follow notification process

RAIN

- Light rain, continue play
- o Heavy Rain without lightning
 - Suspend game play for up to 15 minutes
 - Check weather radar and/or consult with ASL admin
 - If Heavy rain continues, discontinue play (follow rules of play)
 - WHY? Dangerous conditions for players or potential to damage fields that would require heavy repair (time and money)
 - If heavy rains looks to be scattered or passing through quickly, consult with ASL admin, we may delay game starts or just cancel one game and continue others

CANCELLATION OF GAMES:

- If you stop play due to inclement weather, and must discontinue all games for that day of play
 - CONTACT ASL ADMIN THROUGH SLACK IMMEDIATELY AND REPORT INCLUDING REASONS
 - O ASL ADMIN WILL POST ON SOCIAL MEDIA
 - o ASL ADMIN WILL TEXT TEAM CAPTAINS, AS TIME ALLOWS
 - Depending on time of day, ASL may ask that you stick around fields for short time to notify players that may show up to field. Example: stop games at 715 before 730 game (wait to 730 to catch any players that may miss social media/text update)

RULES OF PLAY

-if inclement weather causes you to stop a game before completion follow the below rules:

- 1. You must finish 4th inning or 1st half of game to call game complete\
 - a. Games measured in halves or quarters will be recorded "AS IS" once rule 1 is met.
 - b. If rule one is not met, record the current score, who had possession of ball (down/and position of ball on field) or who was at kick/bat (mark position on batting/kicking order) and number of outs
- 2. if you have finished 4,5,6 inning, you must have score from end of the inning not middle of next inning
 - a. example: home team is winning 6 to 5 after 4 innings, visitor scores 2 runs in top of 5th making it 7-6 then play is stopped due to foul weather. Offical must go back and record score as if it was conclusion of 4th inning and not middle of 5th inning (please make detailed notes of 5th inning) as this will help us with team arguments/challenges
